FATHER JAMES CSASZAR PASSES AWAY



COLUMBUS – Father James Christopher Csaszar died on December 20, 2017, in Chicago, Illinois.

The son of James J. and Roberta Csaszar, he was born February 26, 1973, in Westerville. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from the Pontifical College Josephinum, Columbus, and a Bachelor of Sacred Theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University, Rome, Italy. He was ordained to the Roman Catholic priesthood at St. Joseph Cathedral on June 26, 1999, by the Most Reverend James A. Griffin, Bishop of Columbus.

During his years of priestly service in the Diocese, Father Csaszar served as associate pastor at St. Nicholas Parish, Zanesville, with pastoral duties at Bishop Rosecrans High School; pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish, Kenton; pastor of the Perry County Consortium of Parishes (Saint Rose, New Lexington; Saint Bernard, Corning; Saint Patrick, Junction City; Church of the Atonement, Crooksville); and pastor of Church of the Resurrection Parish, New Albany.

Calling hours will be held on December 28, 2017 from 2-7 p.m. at Church of the Resurrection, 6300 E. Dublin-Granville Road, New Albany, Ohio, where a Vigil Service will begin at 7 p.m.
