

Ross/Pike County Consortium Director of Music Ministry Position

The Director of the Music Ministry coordinates and supervises all aspects of the music programs. Hours vary on scheduled meetings, rehearsals, and liturgies.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Select and prepare appropriate music for (4) weekend liturgies, serve as organist/pianist for weekend Masses, Holy Days, weekly school liturgies, weddings, and funerals. Collaborate with the school music teacher to prepare and rehearse with student cantors for weekly school Masses. Recruit, train, schedule and rehearse with cantors for weekend and Holy Day Masses, weddings, and funerals. Recruit, rehearse and accompany adult and seasonal choirs. Hire and rehearse instrumentalists for special liturgies, responsible for overseeing the repair and maintenance of the organ and other parish instruments. Provides supervision for any concerns held in the church. Participate in Diocesan music workshops and training.

Required Qualifications

Bachelor's degree in music, experience in parish music ministry. Demonstrate excellent organ and piano skills. Competent in diverse musical styles. Strong pastoral and liturgical skills, organizational and planning skills. Active, practicing Roman Catholic.
