Position Summary:

The Learning Center Technology Specialist will work in step with the Technology Coordinator and Dean of Learning Formation to oversee the handling of student devices and work with students in how best to manage their device hardware and software applications for the process of learning in the classroom and at home.

This is a full-time (7:30 a.m.- 4 p.m.), year-round position that reports to the Technology Director and is performed on the campus of St. Charles.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Provide first-tier support for student devices.
- Troubleshooting and upgrading devices.
- Mentor students in the use of applications in the classroom.
- Provide training sessions on a regular basis.
- Perform password resets.
- Assist with copies and printing.
- Order and restock toner for all school printers.
- Manage the device carts.
- Inventory learning assets.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
