- Holy day of obligation
- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

December 28, 2025 (Sunday) The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted
- Mass for the Closing of the Jubilee Year at 10:30 a.m. at St. Joseph Cathedral

December 31, 2025 (Wednesday) Seventh Day within the Octave of the Nativity of the Lord

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted
- Evening Masses observe Mary, the Holy Mother of God

January 1, 2026 (Thursday) Mary, the Holy Mother of God And Special Day of Prayer for World Justice and Peace

- Holy day of obligation
- Mass prayers for Mary, the Mother of God, must be used today
- The Mass for the Preservation of Peace and Justice may not be used today
- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

January 24, 2026 (Saturday) St. Francis de Sales, Principal Patron of the Diocese

- Celebrated as a Feast
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted

February 2, 2026 (Monday) The Presentation of the Lord and World Day for Consecrated Life

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted
- Whenever a procession (n. 1-8) cannot take place, the blessing of candles is celebrated within the Solemn Entrance (n. 9-11)

February 18, 2026 (Wednesday) Ash Wednesday

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted



February 22, 2026 (Sunday) The First Sunday of Lent

- The Rite of Election of Catechumens will be celebrated in English at 1:30 p.m. at St. Catharine Church
- The Rite of Election of Catechumens will be celebrated in Spanish at 4:00 p.m. at Christ the King Church

March 19, 2026 (Thursday) St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary

- Solemnity
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

March 25, 2026 (Wednesday) The Annunciation of the Lord

- Solemnity
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

March 29-April 4, 2026 Holy Week

- Funeral Mass permitted only on Monday-Wednesday
- Ritual Mass not permitted

March 30, 2026 (Monday) Monday of Holy Week

- The Light is ON for You observed from 5-8 p.m.

March 31, 2026 (Tuesday) Tuesday of Holy Week Chrism Mass

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted
- The Chrism Mass will be celebrated. at St. Paul the Apostle Church

April 2, 2026 (Thursday) Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper

- Only one (evening) Mass per church, unless for pastoral reasons the Diocesan Bishop permits another
- Only the sick may receive Holy Communion outside Mass

April 3, 2026 (Friday) Friday of the Passion of the Lord (Good Friday)

- Only one Celebration of the Passion of the Lord per church, unless due to the size or nature of the community, the Diocesan Bishop permits another
- Only the sick may receive Holy Communion outside the celebration of the Lord's Passion

April 4, 2026 (Saturday) Holy Saturday

- Holy Communion only given as Viaticum

The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night

- The entire celebration of the Easter Vigil takes place at night; based on local twilight, the 2026 Easter Vigil may not begin before 8:45 p.m. in this Diocese

April 5-12, 2026 Easter and its Octave

- Easter Sequence permitted throughout the Octave
- Funeral Mass permitted Monday-Saturday, but not on April 12
- Ritual Mass not permitted



May 14, 2026 (Thursday)

- Ascension is transferred to Sunday
- St. Matthias, Apostle
- Celebrated as a Feast
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted

May 15, 2026 (Friday)

- Incorrectly listed in the Roman Ordo as the Day of Prayer for Mental Health Concerns (see May 30, below)
- Optional Memorial of St. Isidore
- Suggested Day of Prayer "At Seedtime"

May 17, 2026 (Sunday) The Ascension of the Lord

- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

May 24, 2026 (Sunday) Pentecost Sunday

- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

May 25, 2026 (Monday)

- Special Day of Prayer for the Honored Dead of the Nation, and for Lasting Peace and General Needs of Humankind

May 30, 2026 (Saturday)

- Day of Prayer for Mental Health Concerns (incorrectly listed in the Roman Ordo for May 15)

June 13, 2026 (Saturday) St. Anthony of Padua, Secondary Patron of the Diocese

- Obligatory Memorial in the Diocese of Columbus
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted

June 28, 2026 (Sunday)

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted
- Evening Masses observe the Sunday
- Vespers observe Vigil of SS. Peter and Paul

July 26, 2026 (Sunday)

- St. Anne, Mother of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Secondary Patroness of the Diocese of Columbus, not observed this year

August 15, 2026 (Saturday)

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

- Not a holy day of obligation
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted
- Evening Masses and Vespers observe the Assumption

September 7, 2026 (Monday)

- Special Day of Prayer for Recognizing the Dignity of Labor and Human Rights and Equality

October 10, 2026 (Saturday)

- Day of Prayer for the Homeless

October 20, 2026 (Tuesday) Anniversary of the Dedication of St. Joseph Cathedral

- Celebrated as a Feast (solemnity in the Cathedral only)
- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

November 1, 2026 (Sunday) All Saints

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted
- Evening Masses and Vespers observe All Saints



November 2, 2026 (Monday) Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted
- All priests permitted to offer three Masses:
 - o one for the priest's intention
 - o one for the faithful departed
 - o one for the intentions of the Holy Father

November 26, 2026 (Thursday)

Special Day of Prayer for the Harvest and Fruits of the Earth

November 29, 2026 (Sunday) The First Sunday of Advent

- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

December 8, 2026 (Tuesday) The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

- Holy day of obligation
- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

December 25, 2026 (Friday) The Nativity of the Lord

- Holy day of obligation
- Funeral Mass not permitted
- Ritual Mass not permitted

December 27, 2026 (Sunday) The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted

December 31, 2026 (Thursday) Seventh Day within the Octave of the Nativity of the Lord

- Funeral Mass permitted
- Ritual Mass permitted
- Evening Masses and Vespers observe Mary, the Holy Mother of God
