The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based method of spiritual formation for children, ages 3-12. Within a specially prepared space called an atrium, this approach invites both children and adults to encounter Christ in Scripture and liturgy.



Using a format that is both retreat-like and informative, this **Level III** course provides the theological and pedagogical foundations for work with **9-12 year old children**. Level III training builds on the foundation of Level II formation. It is only offered to those who have already been formed in CGS at level II.
