Catholic Social Services to welcome JOIN and St. Francis Evangelization Center into its family of ministries!

Columbus, Ohio — [March 27th, 2026] — Catholic Social Services of the Diocese of Columbus (CSS) is pleased to announce that the Joint Organization for Inner-city Needs (JOIN), located in Columbus, and St. Francis Evangelization Center (St. Francis), located in McArthur, are joining the ministry of Catholic Social Services. This change will further strengthen the commitment that the Diocese of Columbus has to social outreach to individuals and families experiencing poverty and hardships across the 23 counties in the diocese, especially central and southeastern Ohio.

Bishop Earl K. Fernandes of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Columbus emphasized the importance of partnership in living out the Church's mission. "The Church is called to be present to those most in need, especially in communities where resources can be limited," Bishop Fernandes said. "The work of JOIN and the St. Francis Evangelization Center reflect the Gospel in action. I am grateful that Catholic Social Services will sustain and grow this mission so that the people of those regions continue to encounter both compassionate service and the love of Christ."

JOIN serves individuals and families in Franklin County by providing emergency financial assistance for those facing economic hardship. At the same time, the St. Francis Evangelization Center has been a vital presence in Vinton County, offering community support, food, and emergency resources to families in that region.

The combined ministry will operate as Catholic Social Services, which has served for 80 years to care for seniors, families, and persons living with disabilities. The combined organization will now serve over 17,000 unique individuals across central and southeastern Ohio.

"JOIN and the St. Francis Evangelization Center have a long and faithful witness of serving our neighbors in central and southern Ohio," said Kelley Henderson, President and CEO of Catholic Social Services, "and this is the right time to combine our ministry in response to the changing needs of Ohio." The Columbus headquartered operations of JOIN will merge into existing locations of Catholic Social Services, while the St. Francis Evangelization Center location in McArthur will become a new expanded community outreach center with more services and a broader reach.

Lisa Keita, the current Executive Director of both JOIN and St. Francis, will oversee the transition and help Catholic Social Services launch this initiative to serve the needs of rural communities in Ohio. "This transition marks an exciting new chapter for JOIN and St. Francis," Keita said, "as we can now expand our reach, and ensure that individuals and families in our community continue to receive the care they deserve."
